## 2011 Formula Abarth Italian Championship



In 2011, Robert Visoiu, at the age of 15, advanced to Formula Abarth and raced in the Italian Formula Abarth Championship and Euro Series Formula Abarth Championship. Robert raced with a prestigious team called Jenzer Motorsport and obtain amazing results in his first year in a single seater. **He won a race in Misano**, after **came a 3<sup>rd</sup> place** in Imola and he finished with a **2<sup>nd</sup> place** in Monza.

2011 – Italian Championship Formula Abarth: 6<sup>th</sup> Place from 24 Drivers

2011 – European Championship Formula Abarth: 4<sup>th</sup> Place from 25 Drivers

2011 – In the last part of 2009 (November-December) Robert Visoiu participated in the Winter Testing for Italian Formula 3 and GP3. He took **1<sup>st</sup> Place** in Italian Formula 3 Winter Testing and managed a **2<sup>nd</sup> Place** in GP3 on the prestigious circuit of Jerez.

## 2012 Plans

For 2012 Robert decided to make the full Italian Formula 3 Championship that consists of 8 races. In addition to this he will also race in 6 races in GP3 preparing him for the 2013 season when he will make the full GP3 program as long as GP2 and World Series by Renault testing.
